Rose Hill Recreation Commission Scholarship Policy

Rose Hill Recreation Commission provides scholarship opportunities due to economic hardship for youth participants residing in the ÛSD 394 boundaries. All requests are confidential. Proof of hardship is required. The following policies apply to the RHRC Scholarship program.

- If scholarship applicants are on the free or reduced lunch program with USD 394 and reside in the USD 394 District boundaries then they qualify for the following scholarship with Rose Hill Recreation Commission.
- 80% discount for up to a maximum of 4 programs per season for each child.
- Participant's parent/guardian will be responsible for the remaining 20% of the regular registration fee plus any appropriate late fees. There is a minimum participation fee of \$5 if the 20% is less than the minimum charge.
- Programs with an activity fee of \$80 or greater will not be eligible for scholarship.
- All participant fees are due at the time of registration.






